15 October	Battle of Agincourt	St. Georges
21 October	Battle of Trafalgar	Ensign + Signal flags
25 October	Battle of Balaklava	Union
26 October	St. Cedd's Day (Essex County Day)	Essex County
31 October	End of the Battle of Britain	RAF

A full list of our flag flying days is posted on the village notice board and on the W.St.P. website.

The St. George flag will be flown most of the time in between other appointed flags.

We fly some Commonwealth country flags, particularly those which include the Union flag, as an acknowledgement of our proud British heritage.
