Food and drink carton recycling

Braintree D.C. have been trialling using banks to recycle cartons such as those used for long-life milk, fresh soups and fruit juices. There are only some 14 locations in the district and Wickham St. Pauls had been chosen, sited at the Victory Inn. The trial finishes on the 21st. June 2021. Hopefully it's been a success.

It accepts paper-based tubes with metal ends, such as gravy granule tubs, hot chocolate tubs, and Pringles tubes, milk and juice cartons.

When you take your cartons to the recycling bank, you should wash them, squash them and put the lids back on cartons and only put paper-based liquid food and drinks cartons in the recycling bin.

Please use it in its final days.

31 May/1 June	Battle of Jutland (1916)	White Ensign

British Columbia is a Canadian province and received Royal Assent from Queen Victoria in 1867. The flag consists of the Union flag at the top (granted in 1906) and the lower half has the sun to represent the glory of the province, while the wavy blue lines represent the Pacific Ocean and the province's position on the western coastline of Canada. A spectacular flag.

We fly some Commonwealth country flags and protectorates, particularly those that have the Union (Jack) canton.

The St. George flag will be flown most of the time in between other appointed flags.
