16 April	Battle of Culloden	(1745)	Kings Colours
21 April	Birthday of Her Majesty the Queen	(b.1926)	Royal Standard
23 April	Saint George's Day	(303 A.D.)	St. George's
25 April	Anzac Day	(1915)	Australian

We fly some Commonwealth country flags, particularly those that have the Union Jack canton, as an acknowledgement of our proud British heritage.

The St. George flag will be flown most of the time in between other appointed flags.
